Welcome back to another season of Highland Dancing! PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING FORM CAREFULLY before registering online.

Registration Dates:

Registration opens online: **August 17, 2017**. Registration will be required before **November** competition deadline to avoid extra non-member fees. It will also be required for registration for the 2017 weekend workshop in November at Kananaskis Village.

Fees:

- We are required by the Alberta Highland Dancing Association (AHDA) to collect \$15.00 per dancer in lieu of fundraising activities. This will be included in the online fee.

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Membership Work Commitment:

- The Calgary Highland Dancing Association (CHDA) is run solely by volunteers. There are no paid positions to run competitions, workshops, pipe practices and other highland events. We count on our membership to assist at events and behind the scenes so that our events are successful. We recognize new dancing families are unfamiliar with what they need do to fulfil their volunteer shifts and we are committed to helping all members learn new volunteer roles. Shifts include: lining dancers up, registration (giving out competitor numbers), running (collecting judges sheets), scrutineering (compiling judges marks), competition set up (am) and clean up (pm), and many other behind the scenes roles. They can be easily learned and many hands make the lifting easier on those members organizing the events.
- Every CHDA member must fulfill their volunteer commitment for the membership year – regardless of the age or level of the dancer. We have excluded primary dancer members. The volunteer shift requirements for each member this year is as follows:
 - Beginner: 1 volunteer shift
 - Novice/Intermediate/Premier: 2 volunteer shifts
 - More than one dancer in the family: 2 volunteer shifts
- Information on the various volunteer roles will be posted on the website or you may contact the CHDA at fling@chda.ab.ca. The volunteer co-ordinator will send out an e-mail with a request from Volunteer Spot in advance of each CHDA competition.
- **You will agree to the above commitment policy when registering online. If you do not meet the requirements by June 8, 2018 you will be invoiced \$50 for each missed shift. Failure to pay this invoice will cancel your membership and make you ineligible for future membership application.**
