CHDA COMPETITION RULES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Special Notes (Restricted Premier):

- A minimum of 100 premier dancers must be entered before Restricted Premier events will be offered. In the event this condition has not been met, the organizer is under NO obligation to advise dancers prior to the competition event.
- A Restricted Premier dancer is defined as one who has not won an overall trophy in a Premier or Restricted Premier class for two years preceding November 18, 2017.
- An overall trophy win is defined as the dancer with the highest total number of points having competed in more than one individual dance in a Premier competition age group that has six or more competitors, thus the name Highest Aggregate Trophy. Winners of special events or one-dance events such as a Hornpipe or Jig, Best-Dressed or Choreography event DO NOT qualify as an overall trophy win. A Championship and a Pre-Championship is considered a Premier event.

1. The competition will be governed by the rules of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (SOBHD).
2. Competitors **MUST hold and present** a current SOBHD registration card.
3. Entries will be accepted online only.
4. **Age as of November 18, 2017**
5. Contact Kara Gillespie at 587-435-6691 or via e-mail at karagillespie@shaw.ca to advise of status change only. Deadline for status changes is November 10th, 2017.
6. There will be **NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS** for any reason.
7. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes any time after the close of entries.
8. The decision of the judges will be final. No persons other than members of the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
9. Complaints must be in written form, signed, accompanied by \$10.00, and submitted to the Competition Chair before the end of the competition. Fee will be refunded if complaint is sustained.
10. Dancers must remain properly attired to collect awards.
11. Dancers will dance in inverse order of entry. First to enter, last to dance.
12. Competitors must fill in the Reel when requested.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR PREMIERSHIPS (Open to Premier dancers only) and Choreography Competition

1. Energy Capital Premiership is sanctioned under the rules and regulations of ScotDance Canada.
2. For Premiership only: Draw for position set by the Competition Committee for all dances.
3. **Age as of November 19, 2017.**
4. Dancers must perform the 2017 Premiership Steps. Hornpipe (4 step for 7 & Under 12 years, 5 step for 12 years & over)
5. Classes will be determined after receipt of entries. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes any time after the close of entries.
6. **Group Choreography (one category for Small and Large):** Dancers may enter one group number. Total time not to exceed 4 minutes.
7. **Solo Choreography: Premier dancers only. Limited to first 16 entries.** Total time not to exceed 2 minutes. Dance and music to be Celtic in theme
