1. Competitors **MUST hold and present** a current SOBHD registration card. Dancers will be fined \$10.00 if the mandatory SOBHD card is not provided at the time of check-in. Any related awards will be withheld until the card is presented to the Competition Chair and/or the Warden.
2. Entries will be accepted by **on-line registration only**. No postal deliveries, hand deliveries, express post, couriers or email.
3. **STATUS CHANGES** - Contact Charlotte Raggett via e-mail at [chdaregistrar@gmail.com](mailto:chdaregistrar@gmail.com) for notification of status change. Deadline for acceptance of status changes is January 14, 2022. No status changes will be accepted the day of the competition.
4. There will be **NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS** for any reason.
5. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes at the close of entries.
6. The decision of the judges will be final. No persons other than members of the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
7. Complaints must be in written form, signed, accompanied by \$10.00, and submitted to the Competition Chair before the end of the competition. Fee will be refunded if complaint is sustained.
8. Dancers will dance in inverse order of entry. First to enter, last to dance.
9. Dancers must remain properly attired to collect awards.
10. All competitors must be current members of Calgary Highland Dancing Association in good standing.
11. **No Late entries will be accepted after January 7, 2022.**

**NOTE:** Premier Dancers in the 16 & over classes receive cash awards but may purchase equivalent medals @ \$2.00 each.

**Beginner, Novice & Intermediate:** Bursaries of \$5 per placing - Awarded to half the class up to 6 places  
**Premier Under 16:** Bursaries of \$10 per placing - Awarded to half the class up to 6 places  
**Premier 16 & Over:** 1st - \$100 2nd - \$90, 3rd - \$80, 4th-\$70, 5th - \$60, 6th - \$50 - Awarded to half the class up to 6 places

### Rules for attending ScotDance Canada Sanctioned Competitions:

- On the competition day, entry into the competition will be allowed only after QR code or contact tracing sheet has been signed and declaration of good health has been provided.
- On the day of the competition, if you are feeling unwell, experiencing COVID-like symptoms, or if you have been asked by Public Health to self-isolate, please stay home.
- If you test positive for Covid following the event, you must contact the competition organizer
- Wearing of masks is strongly encouraged for the safety of all attending. Masks must be worn by all entering the facility if there is a provincial government mask mandate order in effect at the time. **Please bring your own mask!** Dancers may choose to remove mask prior to going on stage for each dance. A bag will be provided for each dancer's mask, if they choose to remove it while competing.
- Physical distancing strongly encouraged at all times while within the facility.
- Only one parent/guardian is allowed in the facility with their dancer(s) if crowd size capacity requirements are in effect.
- All competitors and their parents/guardians are required to exit the facility once their competition events are completed. An exception is where a parent/guardian may be volunteering, and even then, they must exit once their duties have been completed (exiting facility requirements dependent upon crowd size capacity restrictions in effect).
- There will only be one costume change for Beginner, Novice and Premier dancers. Dancers will arrive in their highland costume and

leave in their national costumes. Masks will be worn in the change rooms.

All other dancers are to arrive in costume prepared to dance, hair done and make-up applied. Please bring safety pins to affix number to dance costume.
