## Competition Rules:

1. The Competition is governed by the rules & regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing and ScotDance Canada. All dancers must show a current RSOBHD Dancer Registration card to register.
2. Registration will be accepted online only. Payment for via PayPal or Credit Card. Late entries (after August 26, 2022) will be accepted until August 30, 2022, at regular fees plus \$25/dancer.
3. Entry Fees:

4. All competitors must present a current RSOBHD card stamped for 2022. A fee of \$5 applies to those without cards and awards will be withheld.
5. Age as of September 3, 2022
6. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes at the close of entries.
7. The decision of the Judges will be final. No persons other than the Competition Committee shall communicate with the Judges.
8. Protests must be made in writing, signed, and given to the Competition Secretary along with a \$20 fee before the end of the competition. The fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
9. Dancers will dance in reverse order of entry: Last to enter is first to dance. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called, or they forfeit their right to dance in the event.
10. To receive awards, dancers must be properly attired. i.e. complete costume including dance shoes. Competitors must use the change tents provided as changing in public areas including washrooms is prohibited.
11. There will be NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS for any reason.
12. No trophies will be awarded for Primary dancers.
13. No parents will be permitted in the Line-up area except those of Primary dancers.
14. Cash Awards for Premier 16 yrs & over: **1st \$60, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$40, 4th \$30, 5th \$20, 6th \$20.**  
Restricted Premier 16 yrs & Over: **1st \$50, 2nd \$40, 3rd \$30, 4th \$20, 5th \$10, 6th \$10.**

15. All cash prizes must be signed for.

**RESTRICTED PREMIER RULES:**

- 1) This competition will offer Premier and Restricted Premier events according to the rules and regulations of the RSOBHD and Scotdance Canada.
- 2) A Restricted Premier Dancer is defined as one who has not won an overall trophy in a Premier or Restricted Premier class for four (4) years preceding September 3, 2022.
- 3) Scotdance Canada defines an OVERALL TROPHY win for Restricted Premier purposes as, “the dancer with the highest total number of points having competed in more than one (1) individual dance in a Premier competition age group that has 6 or more competitors, thus the name High Aggregate Trophy”.
- 4) Winners of special dances such as a Special Hornpipe or Special Jig, Best Dressed or Choreography event DO NOT qualify as an overall trophy win. A Championship and Pre-Championship are both considered a Premier event.
- 5) Dancers who meet the requirements for the Restricted Premier class must choose either Restricted Premier or Premier for the competition on September 3, 2022, but not both (i.e. dancers may not compete in Premier and Restricted Premier on the same day)
